THIS IS MY BODY. THIS IS MY BLOOD.

At the Last Supper on the night before he died, Jesus left us a most precious gift, the gift of himself in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. In the Eucharist he has given us a pledge of love that he will always be with us until he returns in glory with all his Angels and Saints. When we receive his body and blood, we are united with Jesus in the most intimate way possible (John 6:56). The Evangelist John also tells us, we have Communion with the Eternal Son of God at the deepest level and not only with the Son, but also with the Father and the Spirit. We receive the life of the undivided Trinity, which is the food essential for our return journey back to the house of our Father. St. Paul tells us that it is in the Eucharist that Jesus calls us to remember his Passion and Death, to recall that he died for each one of us and that on the cross his Sacred body was broken and his precious blood was shed for our salvation. In the Eucharist as at Baptism, we are once again plunged into Jesus' saving death so that our sins are washed away in the fountain of his blood and our spirits nourished with the eternal life of heaven. Let us pray: - 'Father God, on this great feast of Corpus Christi, we rejoice and praise you for the gift of your Son in the Holy Eucharist. We have come to know that in all things he is the way, the truth and the life'.
