#### THE FIRST MIRACLE

Today we join Jesus, Mary and his disciples in the small town of Cana, North of Galilee. This is the first of Jesus' miraculous signs. What was the purpose of this sign? What was the Evangelist John wanting to show us? John provides the answer for us. "He then revealed his glory, and his disciples put their faith in him". Jesus was very generous to this party. Mary said that the couple would be very embarrassed at running out of wine. We are told there were six stone jars meant for the ablutions and this was customary for the Jews. Each jar could hold up to thirty gallons. At Jesus' request the servants filled these 'up to the brim'. Jesus told the servants to draw some out and take it to the steward, he called for the bridegroom and said 'this is the best wine I've tasted'. Jesus is always generous to other people, and always provides in abundance. I wonder are we the same, when we give help to those in need. Jesus gives us an example so let us follow our Lord and try to be more generous when we give help to others, and then we can be sure we are doing our Lord's will and we will be rewarded a thousand times over in our heavenly home. Please help us Lord as we try and follow your example.
