They presented their gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. They were warned by angels of Herod's intention and returned to their homeland by another way. Epiphany is about rejoicing and celebrating the revelation of God in human flesh. Like the Magi, we also are seekers on our human journey. Whatever the age, culture, civilization or nation, believers of all denominations are always searching through faith, looking for the truth and seeking God. 'O Jesus, I rejoice in your presence. I adore you as my Lord and my God in the Holy Eucharist. Never let me forget or take for granted the amazing mystery of your real presence in the Eucharist'.
