We believe that repentance is only possible in this life. We cannot repent, amend or change after we die. Repentance is a fundamental part of the Christian message. We may not like it, we may even resist it, but repentance is foundational in both entering the Christian life and in living it. We must always be prepared to die to ourselves, we must always be repentant and we must always turn to God our Father for grace and mercy. When bad things happen, we think that God is punishing us for our sins or that people are getting their just desserts. Instead, we must allow these to remind us of the shortness of our lives. So, teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom. We need to become wise. Time is getting short. We should ask ourselves am I truly ready to meet the Lord? Where do I need to amend my life? Remember that "All the angels rejoice, for in heaven there is greater joy over the sinner that repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need not repentance".
