SEEING YOUR OWN FAULTS

Jesus stated that love means doing good to people that hate us, praying for those who persecute us and blessing those who curse us. We can see the faults in others but not see them in ourselves. If only we would take the plank out of our own eye we would be able to see more clearly to take the splinter from our brothers eye. In other words we must begin by reforming ourselves. Often we can not see how annoying our behavior is to other people. Jesus was right when he said we have blind spots which prevent us from seeing the planks in our own eyes. When we see failings and really wanted to change, we could try to pray to God today and can help others. We can ask the grace of God to help us and this will be the first step towards reforming ourselves. Then we will be more able to help other people.

SEASON OF LENT

Lent is the time of repentance, prayer and fasting, consisting 40 days starting from Ash Wednesday. It is a day of fasting and abstinence when ashes are blessed and imposed on the foreheads of the faithful to remind of their obligation: to do penance for their sins, to seek spiritual renewal by means of prayer, fasting and good works and by bearing with patience and for God's purposes the trails and difficulties of everyday life.
