Jesus' death was more than just the taking of a human life. The Evangelist John describes it as Jesus' glorification and at the same time as God's glorification. Jesus is united with the Father in love. Jesus revealed God's love to the world, and by accepting death on the cross, He showed the depth of that love. No one could love more than that. It was a love that was entirely without self-interest, and He was willing to give without cost. The New Testament describes this love as 'Agape'. It goes beyond natural love and always involves self-sacrifice and a laying down of one's life. This love is given freely and requires nothing in return. 'Lord, you loved us so much that you were willing to give up your life for us. Fill your people with that same love today and let that love overflow into the world'.
