LOVE ONE ANOTHER AS I HAVE LOVED YOU

The passage from John's Gospel is the last section of Prayer, which concludes Jesus' farewell at the last supper. Jesus prays for the unity among all who will some day come to faith through the words of his disciples. The unity he prays for is the same unity between the Father with Jesus himself that they are one like them. The very fact that Jesus prays for it suggest that it is not available through human striving or association alone. It is not purely spiritual unity. It must be sufficient evidence to confront the world with the powerful truth. We must ensure our neighbours is the way of the love God has for all people. If we show this love by the way we live our lives, then God will dwell in both them and us.
