#### THE LAMB THAT WAS CRUCIFIED HAS RISEN FROM THE DEAD.

Death is an awesome and final reality which we must all face. Someday every one of us will be humbled by the 'grim reaper'. No one can escape it; neither Queen nor pauper; rich nor poor. Death respects no one; in other words, death is everyone's destiny. Our only hope is in the risen Lord Jesus. The only antidote to death's sting is the victory of Christ's resurrection. In the Gospel today, John gives us not a glimpse, but a long reflection on our future in Christ. Today, we encounter a risen body, the first fruits of Christ's resurrection from the dead. Our faith is firmly rooted in the resurrection of Jesus. The hope of our faith is grounded in the truth that just as Christ was raised from the dead, so will we be on the last day - body and soul. "Jesus Christ is risen today: we live and walk and have our b eking in this truth which conquers the world and removes the sting of death".
