TO GOD, THROUGH CHRIST IS THE LOVE POURED OUT BY THE SPIRIT.

As we celebrate the mystery of the Trinity today, we should not feel any sense of being inadequate, because we have not been able to understand the conclusions of perhaps theologians on the 'Trinity', as they have more agile minds than ours. Perhaps it is enough that we would rejoice in the truth of this feast day. The Father has made us a people for his beloved Son, that his Son redeemed us so that we would achieve our eternal destiny in his love, and that his Spirit brings his love to the world, new every morning. We may regard the Trinity as a mystery, however we are told and I don't know how true it is, but it is a good example, that St. Patrick explained the Trinity simply in the shamrock, which has three leaves on one stem, as the three persons - Father, Son and Holy Spirit being one person. 'Thank you, God, for revealing yourself as Trinity, that we may have a foretaste of the wonderful reality which we will know when we see you face to face'.
