#### 'PARABLE OF THE GOOD SAMARITAN'.

What must I do to inherit eternal life? We, just like the lawyer in the gospel must have asked ourselves this same question often. Jesus said 'What is written in the law?'. The lawyer replied that we should love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, with all our strength and with all our mind, and your neighbour as our self. Jesus said that he was right and replied 'Do this and life is yours'. The man then questioned Jesus saying 'Who is my neighbour'?
