Welcome to this House of God:

Talk to God before Mass Listen to God during Mass Talk to others after Mass

"WHERE YOUR TREASURE IS, THERE WILL YOUR HEART BE ALSO".

Jesus' teaching today may seem a little complex in a culture which has become less comfortable with the concept of a master having absolute authority over a servant. However, there is a twofold message - firstly that we should not worry about things which do not matter and secondly, that we should take care to give our attention to things that do. In our lives, we can sometimes allow ourselves to be hooked, like a fish, in becoming dependent on material things which will always let us down. At the beginning of today's gospel, Jesus addresses us, his hearers, tenderly as a 'little flock', and tells us not to be afraid. God is still God, and his love is more precious than any treasure, and more durable than any possession we may have. Also, in the gospel Jesus teaches that while the kingdom has in one sense already come, in another it is still to come, and so it is vital that we be ready to meet the Master whenever he returns, even if it be in the middle of the night. (Luke 11:1,2,8 & 9). "Lord help me not to worry but to be content in the security of your love for me".
