# EVERYONE WHO EXALTS THEMSELVES WILL BE HUMBLED AND THOSE WHO HUMBLE THEMSELVES WILL BE EXALTED,

Jesus was 'gentle and loving in heart' - Matthew tells us (11:29), Jesus came not to be served but to serve. What made it possible for Jesus to live his earthly life in such humble service? Jesus was nourished by his Father's love for him. He knew his true identity - that he was the Son of the Father: At his baptism, Matthew records the Father saying. "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased". This love of the Father made Jesus completely secure in himself. In this love, he had everything. And so, he was able to say to his disciples 'As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you'. We will only become humble as Jesus was and want to serve others as he did, when our security is found entirely in God's love towards us. Then we shall have no need to make ourselves important either in our own eyes or in the eyes of others. 'Lord, teach me to humble myself that I may be exalted'.
