STAY AWAKE, PRAY AND BE READY WHEN THE LORD COMES AGAIN.

In the Gospel today, Jesus addresses his disciples with issues that do not make for easy hearing. Jesus refers to two separate events. The forthcoming destruction of the city of Jerusalem, and the Second Coming at the end of the world. It is at the beginning of Advent that the Church is preparing us for the first coming of Jesus and also reminding us of his Second Coming. These two events could not be more different, the birth of Jesus occurred mainly unnoticed by the world. The Second Coming will be heralded by cataclysmic events that will shake the planet earth and everyone will be aware of this occurrence. So, as we celebrate the first coming, let us not lose sight of who Jesus is and the eternal purpose of his mission to redeem mankind. We should not allow ourselves to be weighed down by trivial concerns or the things we get 'wound up' about so easily. Nor should we waste any time to start getting our lives in order. Now is the time and it is this message we should take into this new season of Advent. THE GOD WHO SPEAKS: A YEAR OF THE WORD

The Catholic Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has designated 2020 as 'The God Who Speaks': A Year of the Word to celebrate the 10th anniversary of Verbum Domini – Pope Benedict XVI's Apostolic Exhortation on 'The Word of the Lord', and the 1600th anniversary of death of St Jerome, who translated the Bible into Latin. Therefore, 2020 will be a year of celebrating, living and sharing God's word, through a range of events, activities and resources, available nationally and in our Diocese. Archbishop Bernard will launch the Year of the Word - The God who Speaks at the 4.30pm Mass on Saturday 30 November - the Vigil of the 1st Sunday in Advent, at St Chad's Cathedral. The Archdiocese of Birmingham is embracing this Scripture initiative and a steering group is already in place to develop how we will celebrate, live and share God's word in 2020.
