JESUS HAS COME TO SEEK OUT AND BRING BACK THOSE WHO WERE LOST.

Zacchaeus was despised by his fellow countrymen because he was in the employment of the Roman authority and was responsible for collecting taxes. As well as the taxes owed to the Romans, these collectors not only demanded the amount owing to the authority, but always asked for more and kept the difference for themselves. Zacchaeus needed the attention of Jesus because he was not happy with his situation. He had become wealthy through his occupation, but was miserable because everyone hated him. He decided to change and Jesus was his opportunity. Because he was a small man, he could not see Jesus over the crowd, so he climbed a nearby Sycamore tree and shouted to Jesus in an attempt to draw his attention. Then Jesus spoke to him "Zacchaeus, come down, because I must stay at your house today". He rushed down and came into the presence of Jesus, took him to his home and confessed his sins. He promised to give to the poor and repay anyone he had overcharged. (An example for all of us to follow). This caused Jesus to say "Today, salvation has come to this house". 'Lord, you give us new hope in this Eucharist. May the power of your love bring us to the joy you promise".
