Today's Mass Readings

2 Samuel 5: 1-3; Ps 121;

Colossians 1: 12-20;

Luke 23: 35-43

LORD, REMEMBER ME WHEN YOU COME INTO YOUR KINGDOM.

This feast day is the climax of the liturgical year and was instituted by Pope Pius XI (1922-1939). Who also canonized Thomas Moore and John Fisher. This feast was originally celebrated on the last Sunday of October, but after Vatican II is was moved to the last Sunday of November. The promise of Jesus to the 'good thief' is something of a climax. It is the last act of kindness of Jesus before he commends his Spirit to the Father. (Today you will be with me in Paradise). The Father has created a place for each and everyone of us in this kingdom. His plan is that we should freely enter into his kingdom. But since God gives us freedom, he will not compel us to enter. When Jesus returns, we will have to acknowledge him as Lord and King. We can either invite Jesus to be our King and reign in our lives, or we can refuse him that authority and exclude him altogether. I know what I want to do. I want to praise Jesus for all he has done, just like the 'good thief'. I want to invite Jesus to reign in our hearts. Give Jesus your life. Make our confession of faith and say "Jesus, remember me, when you come into your kingdom". And hope we will hear Jesus' reply as he did to this unknown thief. 'Lord Jesus, you are my king and my God. Rule my heart with your love and peace'.
