### Dear Parishioners,

I hope that you all are staying safe and well in this challenging time due to the coronavirus pandemic. In this week's newsletter I would like to give a glimpse of hope for re-opening our church for individual prayers.

I have received a letter and guidance from our Archdiocese. This guidance and letter gives initial guidelines and steps to consider for the re-opening of our church for individual prayers only. As and when the decision to open churches is made in principle we will then be given a Risk Assessment Form for completion. We have to complete the Risk Assessment Form via the online Diocesan Health and Safety platform.

In order to re-open our church we need a team of people to make a plan, to execute the guidelines and to complete the Risk Assessment Form for the re-opening. If you can help on this matter please contact Fr. Vincent SCJ or the Parish Office. We need also to make a Task Force Team to guide and help the people once the church is open for the individual prayers. This Task Force Team includes **Stewards, Cleaners, etc...** to help and assist the people. We need adequate volunteers to support the process. Those who are interested in assisting and helping please contact the Parish Office or Fr. Vincent SCJ. Please note that the guidance, which is given to us, states that this excludes those who are deemed vulnerable (over 70 years, and/or with certain pre-existing health conditions, self-isolating or shielding).

In advance I would like to say a big thank you for your help and time towards your parish. Finally, be assured of my prayers and be safe.
