#### TELL ME TO COME TO YOU ACROSS THE WATER

After the feeding of the five thousand, Jesus told the disciples to get into their boat and travel across the Sea of Galilee while he organized sending the large crowd away. Then Jesus went up the hill by himself to pray to his Father. We are told in the Scriptures, that about the fourth watch of the night - that would be between 3am and 6am in the dead of night and the very first light of dawn. The disciples saw Jesus walking on the lake and coming towards them. The disciples were battling against heavy sea and a strong headwind. They thought first of all that it was a ghost. Jesus called to them and said "Courage, it is I. Do not be afraid.". Peter then said "Lord if it is you, tell me to come across the water to meet you". Peter got out of the boat and started to walk towards Jesus, but as soon as he felt the wind he began to sink and cried out "Lord, save me". Jesus took him by the hand and joined the others on the boat and the wind died down. Jesus walking on the water was a miracle and also a sign of Divinity. Who else could do this or calm the wind? Only God, because only God can promise true and everlasting peace. 'Lord bring your peace to my life, still the wind and waves of fearfulness and help me to rely on your love and your plan for me'.
