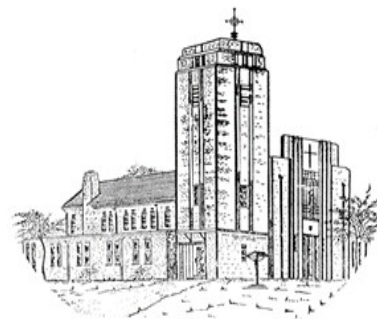

**New Guidelines for Mass and other Liturgical Services in
Church**

- **Maximum capacity of our church for the Mass is 68 people only.**
- **First come, first served.**
- **Be considerate, patient and understanding.**
- **Follow 2 metre social distancing all the time in Church and its premises.**
- **Sanitise hands on entry & exit.**
- **Wear a mask or face coverings all the time in church. If you have any serious breathing problem or health issues please inform one of the stewards. Children under 5 are exempted.**
- **To light a candle please ask one of the stewards. Do not touch the candles**
- **Receive Holy communion in silence in your hand only, not on your tongue.**
- **No Congregating in church and its premises .**
- **Please stay at home if you may have a pre - existing condition or are immuno-compromised.**
- **Please stay at home if you are feeling ill.**
- **Please stay at home if you suspect you may be ill or have been exposed to Covid 19.**
- **Please stay at home if you have a sick family member at home.**
