# THE SHEEP THAT BELONG TO ME LISTEN TO MY VOICE, SAYS THE LORD. I KNOW THEM AND THEY FOLLOW ME.

The message of the parable of the two sons is repentance. The Father asks both sons to spend the day working in the vineyard. The first son refuses, but the second son agrees to go at once (but did not go). What made the first son change his mind, we do not know. The important thing is that he did change his mind. We tend to think repentance as a turning away from sin which it is of course, but it is also an attitude of mind and heart and always wanting to be right with God.

If sin threatens to overwhelm us, we can take comfort with the words of St. Therese of Lisieux "I am certain that if my conscience were burdened with every sin it is possible to commit. I would still go and throw myself into our Lord's arms; I know what tenderness he has for any prodigal son of his who comes back to him".

"Dear Jesus, give us courage to respond to your call. Help us to make a positive contribution to society in your name. Amen.
