Today's Mass Readings

Apocalypse 7:2-4, 9-14; Ps 23; I John3:1-3; Matthew 5:1-12

REJOICE AND BE GLAD, FOR YOUR REWARD WILL BE GREAT IN HEAVEN.

The feast of All Saints celebrates all those holy men and women whose lives have become configured to Christ. This feast dates back to the beginning of the 7th century when the Pope consecrated the Pantheon, which had been a Roman temple, as a Church in honour of the martyrs of Rome. Legend has it that the bones of these martyrs buried in the catacombs were re-buried under the floor of the Pantheon. On this feast day we celebrate and rejoice that the saints are in heaven, and will see God face to face. We must cultivate the godly impulse to think about heaven often. St. Basil the Great said of heaven and the beatific vision: 'There true peace will reign, where no one will experience opposition either from self or from others. God himself will be virtue's reward; he gave virtue and has promised to give himself as the best and greatest reward that could exist. St. Augustine said "Lord God Eternal Father, we set our hearts on things above, in the hope of understanding you without end, praising you without weariness and loving you forever. O Beauty so ancient yet ever new".


