CHRIST, GOD'S WISDOM AND LIGHT THAT DISPELS OUR DARKNESS

On this Sunday, we continue to savour the joy of the new born king, we continue to greet the Word made flesh that now dwells among us as wisdom of God. The wisdom of God dispels our darkness and illuminates our lives. There is a very strong relationship between wisdom and light. In fact, they are synonymous to each other. Light is always contrary to darkness and dispels it. The Book of Wisdom addresses God as the one who "made all things by your word; God's eternal, creative, and illuminating power". Light, Word and Wisdom are seen as one and the same.

This is what the birth of Christ did for us this season. As the wisdom of God, Christ came to abolish ignorance by revealing things that are hidden for ages. As Wisdom He enlightens the eyes of our mind so that we can appreciate God. As light, he not only clears the obscurities of our mind, but also lights up our way. This is echoed in the Psalm 119:"Your Word is a lamp for my feet and a guide for my path."

In today's Gospel reading, the evangelist John describes Jesus as God's life, light giving and creative Word that has come to us in human form.
