### CHRIST THE LORD IS RISEN TODAY: ALLELUIA, ALLELUIA!

Easter is the greatest and the most important feast in our faith for three reasons. Firstly, The Resurrection of Christ is the foundation of our Christian Faith. The Father raised Jesus to life and placed him at his right hand in glory. That is why St. Paul writes: "If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain; and your Faith is in vain. Jesus is Lord, He is risen!" The founder of no other religion has an empty tomb as Jesus has. After witnessing the empty tomb, the disciples remembered that Jesus had prophesied his Resurrection, and they believed and preached this message to the whole world.

Secondly, Easter is the guarantee of our own resurrection. Jesus assured Mary and Martha at the tomb of Lazarus that "I am the Resurrection and the Life; whoever believes in Me will live even though he dies."

Finally, Easter is a feast which gives us hope and encouragement in this world of pain, sorrows, and tears. It reminds us that life is worth living. It makes us believe in the Real Presence of the Risen Christ in His Church, in the Blessed Sacrament, and in Heaven. It gives meaning to our personal and communal prayer. It gives us strength to fight against temptation, and freedom from unnecessary worries and fears.

Let us therefore echo the words of the Psalmist on this glorious day of Easter: "This day was made by the Lord; we rejoice and are glad." Alleluia!
