Today's Mass Readings

Acts 9: 26-31; Ps 21; 1 John 3: 18-24; John 15:1-8

BEARING GOOD FRUIT IN CHRIST

Today's Gospel Reading presents us with another title of Jesus: "I am the true vine". This is the last of the seven "I am" declarations of Jesus recorded only in John's Gospel. Jesus made this proclamation to his apostles and all those who would come to believe in him, shortly before his Ascension into heaven.

By using the metaphor of the vine and the branches, Jesus teaches about the relationship between his disciples and himself. The type of relationship that should exist between us and Christ is illustrated using what is familiar to his disciples in his time. Jesus wanted to reassure his followers that even though they would not see him physically as they used to, he would however still be united with them in his spiritual reality. He wanted us to know that, even though we cannot see him, we are closely connected to him as the branches of a vine are connected to its stem. This unity between Jesus and his disciples is the basis for their ability to continue to do the work that he began. Similarly, Jesus' presence with us through the Gift of the Holy Spirit enables us to continue the work of Jesus' love and reconciliation in the world.

No branch can have life or bear fruit on its own, unless it is firmly attached to a tree. Likewise, in our spiritual journey as Christians, we cannot do without being firmly attached to Christ the vine, in whose name we were baptized. We are formed and called to remain in Christ for a purpose, and this purpose is to bear good and positive fruit in him.

Jesus, the True Vine is communicating to us his branches that the will of the Father for us is to bear much fruit and become his disciples. So, let us ask God to nourish us with his spirit, so that we may remain in him and bear good fruit that will benefit others.


