### Today's Mass Readings

Acts 1: 15-17,20-26; Ps 102; 1 John 4:11-16; John 17:11-19

### **Dear Brothers and Sisters,**

This Sunday's Gospel Reading is the continuation of Jesus' farewell discourse delivered to the disciples at the Last Supper. In this discourse we hear about Jesus' prayer in which Jesus is commending himself to the Father and expressing his care and concern for his disciples and us. In this priestly prayer of Jesus, he reaffirms the complete union between himself and the Father and he includes all his disciples in this union with the Father. We are reminded that Christ is the source of Christian unity. Through Christ, we are united with one another and with God Our Father.

Another aspect of this Jesus' prayer is about His Mission. Jesus describes his mission in the language of protection. His disciples have been protected from evil by Jesus' presence. Now that Jesus has ascended to the Father, he prays that his disciples will continue to be protected from the evil one. This echoes the prayer that Jesus taught to his disciples, the Lord's Prayer, "deliver us from evil".

Finally, this prayer of Jesus also speaks about the consecration of his disciples. "Consecrate them in the truth; your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world, and for their sake I consecrate myself so that they too may be consecrated in truth". Consecration is the rite by which a person or a thing is given completely to God. in the First Reading, Matthias who was a witness to the Resurrection was chosen to take over the ministry and apostolate which Judas abandoned. He was given over completely to God by being officially named as one of the twelve apostles. Through our Baptism, we belong completely to God, we are totally consecrated. We must show this consecration through the love and unity we show towards our brothers and sisters.


