BIRMINGHAM'S CLEAN AIR ZONE

From 1 June 2021 Birmingham will launch a Clean Air Zone. It will operate 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The charges will be applied daily. A non-compliant vehicle driving in the Zone will pay once for the day, and may then drive in the area without limit on that day. 
