

HOLY WEEK AND EASTER.

Holy Thursday: The Washing of the Feet is restored. The celebrant should wear a face covering whilst performing this rite.

Good Friday: The Veneration of the Cross is also restored. When you approach the Cross, please do not kiss the Cross but bow to reverence it.

Easter Vigil: The Easter Vigil is restored in its full Rite. The faithful gathering for the ceremonies can have candles. The sprinkling of the Holy Water on the faithful during is permitted.
