# My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ

This was the third time that Jesus appeared to the disciples after rising from the dead. The main theme of this Gospel passage is the confession of faith made by Peter. At the time of Jesus's trial during the night Peter denied Jesus three times before three different people. It was Peter's duty to strengthen his fellow apostles but he denied Jesus and the other apostles were scattered. Jesus had made Peter the foundation of the church and therefore the head of the apostles. "You are the "Petra" upon which rock I shall build my Church". Everything was up turned upside down on that night of Jesus's Passion. After the Resurrection Jesus appeared only to His disciples and the women who followed Him. This was to strengthen His close associates and to empower them to go out and preach the Gospel.

Jesus asked Peter "Simon son of John, do you love me more than these others do?" He said "Yes Lord You know I love You." By asking Peter the same question three times, Jesus reaffirmed Peter's fidelity to His Master. Three times Peter denied and three times he affirmed that he loved Jesus as a penance for his sin of denial. Even in the case of Peter Jesus kindly corrected his misdeed and reinstated him to his original status as the head of the apostles. When God entrusts a responsibility to a person He demands fidelity from that person. In our lives sometimes we also knowingly or unknowingly deny God due to the pressure of circumstances. We have to repair that by proclaiming our faith whenever it is needed in deed and word. Fidelity to Jesus Christ and His Gospel is a prerequisite to following Him as a true Christian.
