# My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ

Today is the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, three Persons with one Godhead: God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. We cannot fully understand this doctrine with our human intellect. It is a divine mystery we understand in faith. When Our Lord Jesus Christ was in this world, He explained to His disciples the existence of the Father and the Holy Spirit. Regarding their mutual relationship Jesus Christ says: I and my Father are One and the Holy Spirit whom the Father sends. Theologically speaking the essence and the existence of the three Persons of the Holy Trinity is one and the same. What the Father thinks is the same as the Son and the Holy Spirit. St. Ephrem, a fourth century theologian of the Church explains this mystery of the Trinity in the following way. He compares the Holy Trinity to the sun. From the sun comes light and heat so also from God the Father comes the Son as the Light of the world and the Holy Spirit as heat. Christian faith is basically the Trinitarian faith. We believe in God the Father, Creator of heaven and earth, God the Son, Redeemer of the world and God the Holy Spirit who renews and guides the Church. On the basis of this doctrine of faith every time we pray, we start with the Trinitarian formula: "In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." All the official prayers and blessings of the Church also end in praise of the Holy Trinity. In whatever manner we try to explain Holy Trinity we cannot fully comprehend this doctrine. It is a mystery which we can understand only through the eyes of faith and with the light of the Holy Spirit. We pray to God: Lord God enlighten our minds and hearts to understand this reality and believe in the Triune God without doubt because without Your divine revelation we are helpless to understand it. As Jesus Christ says no one knows the Father only the Son knows the Father and those to whom He wants to reveal Him. (Mt 11: 27)
