#### **Dear brothers and sisters in Christ**

It is our firm conviction that we are created from the earth (as God's beloved dust), that God's grace gives us life, and we are connected with the rest of humanity and with all living things. We are mortal beings, our bodies will become dust when buried and ashes if cremated, and our lifespan is very brief and unpredictable. Lent is a loving invitation to realize and acknowledge our sinful condition and to return to our loving and forgiving God with true repentance as the prodigal son did.

We need to purify and renew our lives during the period of Lent by repentance, by expressing sorrow for our sins, by turning away from the temptation to sin and by turning to God. We express our repentance by becoming reconciled with God daily, by asking for forgiveness from those we have offended and by giving unconditional forgiveness to those who have offended us.

When St. John Chrysostom speaks about Fasting; he asks "Do you fast? Give me proof of it by your works. If you see a poor man, be moved to pity for him. If you see an enemy, be reconciled to him. If you see a friend being honoured, do not envy him.

Do not let only your mouth fast, but also the eye and the ear and the feet and the hands and all the members of your bodies. Let the hands fast, by being free of avarice and greed. Let the feet fast, by ceasing to run after sin. Let the eyes fast, by disciplining them not to stare at that which is sinful. Let the ear fast, by not listening to evil talk and gossip. Let the mouth fast from ugly words and gossip".
