Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ

God loves us with the same love that He loves the Son. It is a complete, total, uncompromising love that sacrifices all things to bring us back to Himself. Sin separates us from God. We cannot pray to him, we cannot reach out to him, we cannot benefit from him spiritually or eternally. We are lost, hopeless and spiritually dead, but God has given us the greatest expression of love that one can have. No one has greater love than this: that someone lays down his life for his friends. When Jesus laid down his life for us, it had eternal results. He rescued us from eternal death. There are no limits to Jesus' love. There is nothing temporary in the blessings that God gives through Jesus' life, death, and resurrection.

Jesus is adamant, "Remain in my love", because to do otherwise would be discarding all the blessings that God has given. If we prefer entertainment, work, family, friends or anything else, then we risk losing his love. Jesus said, "You did not choose me, but I chose you." He decided to save us. He sent the Holy Spirit through his Word to create faith in our hearts, which brought us from the death of unbelief to a new life lived for him.

Everything that we are or have through Jesus is because of Jesus. We are branches connected to the vine. Our good works are the evidence of our God-given faith. Good works do not cause Jesus' love but they are an outward expression of His love in us. When Jesus says that we should love like he does, he is speaking about the spirit of that love, the motivation of that love. It means using our time, money and energy to help someone in need. In this way, we show that we remain in Jesus' love. May we always remain in this love that was freely given to us.
